On proclamation by Sheriff Hunt, the Honorable County Board was declared to be in session pursuant to adjournment.

MINUTES

MOTION was made by Manint, seconded by Spencer, that the minutes of the June 14, 2017, meeting be approved as read and recorded. On voice vote, motion carried.

COUNTY TREASURER'S REPORT
