Minutes

The Mapping Committee of the Piatt County Board met on Wednesday, December 6, 2017 in Room 104 of the Courthouse. The meeting was called to order at 10 a.m. by Chairman Al Manint. Attending were: Manint, Robert Murrell, Ray Spencer, Randy Keith, Eric Seibring, and Keri Nusbaum.

MOTION: Spencer made motion, seconded by Murrell to approve the minutes of the November 1, 2017 meeting as written. All in favor, motion carried.

There was no old business.

New Business:

Expense claims for November were presented. <u>Motion:</u> Spencer made motion, seconded by Murrell to approve the claims of \$267.50. Roll was called, all in favor and the motion carried.

Safety: There were no safety concerns.

Comments: Bob Murrell brought up concerns that the maps are not being utilized as they could or should be. He said there are properties which are not assessed or taxed properly. Money has been spent for the flyover, and it is not being used to its full potential. Nusbaum said that the township assessors and the Supervisor of Assessments receive the complete list of all building permits issued each year. If the building is permitted, it should be on the tax rolls. Seibring said that one of the intended purposes of the flyover is as a tool for the assessors.

The committee will ask Sandy Schlosser to attend next month's meeting with a township assessor if possible to answer questions about how the County Board could help them use the tools available to them.
