MOTION: Carroll made motion, seconded by Shumard to approve the minutes of the February 7, 2019 meeting as written. All in favor, motion carried. There was no mapping committee meeting in March.

New Business:

The invoice from CCGIS for the period 1/1/2019- 2/23/2019 was presented for payment. One of the items charged for was an updated tax map book. Jennifer Bryant said it won't be necessary to update the tax book yearly since the online is available.

<u>Motion:</u> Carroll made motion, seconded by Shumard to authorize Jennifer Bryant to change the tax book updates with CCGIS at her discretion. Roll was called, all in favor and the motion carried.

<u>Motion</u>: Carroll made motion, seconded by Shumard to approve the expense of \$1824.50 to CCGIS. Roll was called, all in favor and the motion carried.

Bryant questioned when the planning for the next flyover will begin. There was discussion about the funds available, and what they could be used for. Spencer said there will be hard choices, and the flyover may be something to be cut. Seibring questioned whether all the funds could be swept, since fees are charged at recording to sustain the fund.
