RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND INTERNET

Minutes

August 8, 2019

The Resource Conservation and Internet Committee of the Piatt County Board met on Thursday, August 8, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 104 of the Courthouse. The meeting was called to order by Committee Chairman Shannon Carroll. Attending were: Carroll, Robert Murrell, Randy Shumard, Ray Spencer and Keri Nusbaum. Also attending were: States Attorney Rhoades, Jennifer Harper, Seth Floyd, Linda Leach, Mike Holmes, Jennifer Bryant, EC Gupton and Sheriff Hunt.

<u>Motion:</u> Spencer made motion, seconded by Murrell to approve the minutes of the July 9, 2019 meeting as written. All in favor, and the motion carried.

The email options were discussed. Spencer would like everyone to be on the same domain. The states attorney's office would like the government domain along with the sheriff and probation.

Gupton said that the installation, migration and other labor for any changes would be charged by the hour. Spencer said there would be some expense in cards, letterhead, etc. Emails could be forwarded for 6 months to a year. Floyd remarked that the expense of another migration would be a problem for his office.

Rhoades questioned whether each department head is to budget for these changes. Budgets have been submitted and may need to be amended.

Gupton suggested if piattcounty.org was kept, it could be transitioned to the G series. He will check on that possibility.

Holmes explained that using .gov was not necessary to have a government tenant. Piatt.gov can be attached to the government tenant but only if all would switch. Gupton said it makes sense to discuss one of two domains. Either piatt.gov or piattcounty.org. The G tenant can be on either.

Gupton said the G series is on a different set of servers, and the added security is in that the 'back end' support is background checked.

<u>Public Comments</u>: Bryant commented she would prefer consistency for all with email and website.

<u>Motion</u>: Shumard made motion, seconded by Spencer to adjourn. All in favor, and the meeting was adjourned at 9:50 a.m.
