Directors Report

Aaron Leynes presented the report. They received the old radios from the Sheriffs department. These can be used for search and rescue and in the mobile command unit. Leynes and Wilhelm participated in a tabletop exercise for school shooter with the Sheriff's department at Monticello schools. Kirby Ambulance is trialing the Tango Tango cell phone application. Leynes will follow up to get their input. They have been following weather bulletins and posting on social media as needed. The LEPC meeting schedule for 2025 has been approved and posted. Leynes presented at the Piatt County Nursing Home men's coffee group. Submissions for third and fourth quarter grants were completed.

Leynes discussed the need for an expansion or location change of the EMA department in the future. Possibilities include expanding the current offices into adjoining spaces, re-configuring the current space, or building a new structure to allow for storage of the trailers and command center. There is a need for space to allow for training and exercises.

The next meeting is scheduled for February 19 at 9 a.m., however the County Board has been moved to that time.
